A message from Rick Fadness about foundation insurance:

“One coverage the MG Foundation should be getting is Public Liability coverage. Most facility use agreements require it. Our self-insurance doesn’t provide for it.

This is a broad form of insurance to pay members of the public for death and injury or damage to property or possessions, which has resulted from the business’s activities. The SILP has the additional requirement i.e., resulting from the negligence of WSU.”
