## SOUTH KOREAN MG CONFERENCE

**Conference dates and locations (updated):** The main conference will occur September 25-28, 2014, at the GyeonGi-Do Agricultural Research and Extension Service (GARES) and the National (Korean) Institute of Horticultural and Herbal Science, near Suwon, South Korea. An extended session of the conference will occur on Jeju Island on September 29 – October 1. Participants from the US should plan to travel to Korea (Incheon International Airport, ICN) and arrive by September 24 (**this will usually require departure from US on September 23**). For those participating in the Jeju Island part of the conference, a **departure date from Incheon International Airport should be October 2, or September 29 if you are not going to Jeju Island**. (Travel to/from Jeju Island will be from Gimpo Airport (Korean domestic), these arrangements will be announced later.) The evening of October 1 will be spent near either Gimpo or Incheon airports, both are fairly close to Seoul. If you want to extend your stay in South Korea or Asia in general, the Seoul area offers many tourist and cultural opportunities. The basic schedule of the conference as outlined in my original email below has not changed except that one day of the conference will not occur at the National Institute of Horticultural and Herbal Science. A web site should be available soon with further details regarding the conference. The details for how to apply to be a speaker are attached.

## PESTSIGHTINGS

During your springtime activities, there are a few different insects that you should be aware of. One of those that will be emerging soon, is the red lily leaf beetle. Our own Sharon Collman has been tracking the development of this pest as it has only been found in King County. Please keep your eyes open for this pretty beetle with a very ugly, snotty larvae. You won't confuse it with anything else on your lilies.
